## May 25th, 2021 CARM Release 1 - CBSA clients are able to:



- ✓ Create & manage their accounts on the portal
- ✓ Classify goods & estimate their duties & taxes
- ✓ Make secure payments online via the portal
- ✓ Delegate access to their service providers
- ✓ Submit ruling requests & track their progress

## Spring 2022 CARM Release 2 - Additional features:

- ✓ Register for a business number and enroll in CBSA programs
- ✓ Obtain statements of account (SOA) in real time
- ✓ Submit appeals & track their progress
- ✓ Submit a Commercial Accounting Declaration
  - This will replace today's custom coding (B3) and adjustment request (B2) forms

## How will Release 2 affect you?



### REQUEST FOR CLEARANCE INTO CANADA

Duty and tax no longer paid to CBSA at the time of release by customs brokers.

- You will need to assign your customs broker to make these payments on your behalf or conduct this directly in the CCP.



### FINANCIAL SECURITY

Cash bond posted in the CCP or a D120 import bond in the Importer's name.

- You will no longer be allowed to utilize a custom broker's import bond.



### PAYMENT OF DUTIES AND TAXES TO CBSA

**MUST** be paid in the CCP.


- Additional payment methods are available, including delegating to your customs broker (additional charges may apply).
- Updated billing cycles and payment due dates.

- Register for an account on the CARM Client Portal **before** the Spring 2022 deadline.
